


Length of Sobriety

73% of members have been sober for more than 2 years. Here are the percentages:


- 46% have over 10 years sobriety
- 27% have between 2 & 10 years
- 7% have between 1 & 2 years
- 20% have up to 1 year



Attendance at meetings

45% of members attend 3 or more meetings per week.

- 6% attend 5 or more a week
- 39% attend 3 to 4
- 55% attend 1 to 2
- 2% attend less than 1 per week



The two stage survey of Continental European Region was conducted between March and September 2005.



Introduction to AA


The factors most responsible for members coming in to AA are:

- 45% Through an existing member
- 10% Looked up number in phone book.
- 16% Came through a treatment centre.
- 4% Found AA through a GP
- 4% Had tried AA before
- 4% Saw an AA leaflet
- 3% Saw a notice about meetings
- 6% Saw an advert in a newspaper
- 4% Came through an Al-Anon or Alateen member
- 1% Heard about AA on the radio
- 0% Found details on the internet
- 2% Saw an advert on TV




Length of Membership

3% have been members for between 1 & 2 years




Sponsorship
