


Length of Sobriety

Around 60% of our membership have been sober for more than 2 years. Here are the percentages:


- 28% have over 10 years sobriety
- 33% have between 2 & 10 years
- 9% have between 1 & 2 years
- 29% have up to 1 Year



Attendance at meetings

61% of members attend 3 or more meetings per week.

- 17% attend 5 or more a week
- 44% attend between 3 & 4
- 37% attend between 1 & 2
- 2% attend less than 1 per week



At the time the survey was taken there were 3,630 AA Groups in the UK.

From the survey the average number of members per group was calculated to be 9.5

From these figures the total membership of the fellowship can be estimated to be about 34,000

It is on this figure that the statistics used in this pamphlet were based.



Introduction to AA


The factors most responsible for members coming in to AA are:

- 28% Through an existing member
- 23% Looked up number in phone book.
- 20% Came through a treatment centre.
- 10% Found AA through a GP
- 6% Had tried AA before
- 2% Saw an AA leaflet
- 2% Saw a notice about meetings
- 2% Saw an advert in a newspaper
- 2% Came through an Al-Anon or Alateen member
- 1% Heard about AA on the radio
- 1% Found details on the internet
- 1% Saw an advert on TV




Length of Membership

 8% have been members for between 1 & 2 Years.




Sponsorship
