- ① Ros R provided the meeting with the summary of this year's LNKIG convention

which is being held at Chislehurst Caves (ie. the same venue as in 2023) on 23 March 2024. Tickets are still available. It looks to be a great afternoon, with some popular speakers, a debate on whether AA is a religious or a spiritual program, food and a tour of the caves. Current Committee is Ros, Vic (Treasurer) and Nick, with support from within the Fellowship. Natasha has joined the committee for 2025, but nobody else has come forward to help yet. Nick pointed out that attendance from GSRs and other LNKIG members was virtually nil last year, and would be appreciated this year.

- ① Quarterly Newsletter it was agreed that Nick would produce the Newsletter on a regular basis.
