- Convention 2025 Ros advised that the Convention is diarised for Saturday March 22nd 2025, at United Reform Church adjacent to The Glades on Widmore Road in Bromley. Not to be publicised until formally booked.

- Questions For Conference GSRs are responsible for collating responses to the questions which have been published. There are workshops available online on 14th, 21st and 28th January on Zoom where Delegates from Region will explain the process.
- Annual Accounts Alan was not in attendance but the Annual Accounts were presented to the committee. The Income for the Year 1st November 2023 to 4th November 2024 was £9682.35, and Outgoings were £8910.45.

The opening balance was £3481.90, the closing balance was £2447.03.

Following the vote at the last meeting £500 has been held back for the Convention, and £500 is held as prudent reserve for running costs. £1447.03 is available to send through to Region however this was not voted on. Proposal is to obtain ratification of this via WhatsApp group post the meeting.

<u>Health</u>

Martin H reported that the PRUH and Green Lanes support are successfully in place and running smoothly. There has been a positive change recently that feedback has been asked for from volunteers which the health providers have found very helpful. Martin requested feedback in respect of a proposal to provide a "coin" which has the details of AA on it, as per the coin produced by The Cockney Convention. Vic to find out if the coin is "AA approved collateral".
