

A year of Service: Carrying the AA Message

The Nottingham and Leicestershire AA Intergroup 2026

- Income from groups and events £17,106
- Sent to GSO £8,631
- Primary purpose expenditure £8,475

Our team of 30 volunteers has answered over 4,000 calls from people looking for help with their alcohol problem. Cost £150

Weekly AA meetings are held in 4 local prisons. This is made possible by a team of volunteers who are reimbursed for their travel expenses. Cost £4,441. We have also allocated funding for Big Books and other AA literature to be made available in prison libraries. Cost £500

The NLIG micro-website has now been repopulated and is being continually updated. This follows an extensive upgrade of the main AA website.
